Traditionally, insects defined in this way were divided into "Apterygota" (the first five groups in the table) "the wingless insects" and Pterygota "the winged insects. However, modern phylogenetic studies have shown that "Apterygota" is not monophyletic, and so

does not form a good taxon.
